He has been with the Regional Water Board for over 8 years, spending the last 2 years in the Redding Office. Mr. Jensen implements the Clean Water Act Section 401 Water Quality Certification Program for the northern region, including the counties of Modoc, Siskiyou, Lassen and Shasta. In addition, Mr. Jensen implements the Storm Water Regulatory Program, including the Municipal Storm Water Permitting Program, the Construction Storm Water Program and the Industrial Storm Water Program for the northern region.
