Environmental Coordinator**

Topic: In this presentation, Mr. Mayer will talk about the former McClellan Air Force Base, and McClellan's role as the first privatized clean-up of a Superfund site in the nation. Hear about McClellan's vast amount of environmental clean-up, the process, what's been done, what the schedule is, and more!

Speaker Biography: Mr. Steven K. Mayer is the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Environmental Coordinator for the former McClellan AFB and is stationed at the Air Force Real Property Agency's Western Execution Center at McClellan, California. He is responsible for environmental remediation of contaminated sites, protecting and maintaining facilities and disposing of excess Air Force property at McClellan AFB. Mr. Mayer oversees all aspects of accelerated cleanup, program management, and disposal of all excess base property. He works closely with the local redevelopment agency (Sacramento County) and developer (McClellan Business Park) to expedite the property transfer process and coordinate the cleanup effort to support future reuse.

Mr. Mayer earned a Bachelor of Science in Geological Engineering from the University of Minnesota and is a Registered Professional Civil Engineer in the State of California. Mr. Mayer has been working environmental issues at McClellan AFB in various staff and supervisory capacities since joining the Air Force in a civilian capacity in 1989. Prior to joining the Air Force, Mr. Mayer worked for nine years as a field engineer and sales engineer in the oil industry for Schlumberger Ltd.
