Speaker Biography: Jim Moose is a partner in the Sacramento law firm of Remy, Thomas, Moose and Manley, LLP. He received his bachelor's degree from the University of California at Berkeley in 1981 and his juris doctor degree from the same university (Boalt Hall School of Law) in 1985. Along with his partners Mike Remy (who died in 2003), Tina Thomas, and Whit Manley, he is the co-author of Guide to the California Environmental Quality Act, which since 1987 has been published periodically by Solano Press Books and has frequently been cited in reported Court of Appeal decisions interpreting CEQA. The most recent edition was published in the winter of 2007. He has also been an attorney of record in a number of published Court of Appeal precedents on CEQA. He has testified in the California Legislature on environmental issues, and has participated in drafting amendments to CEQA and other environmental laws. Since the late 1980s, he has taught courses on CEQA through the University of California at Davis Extension Program. Starting in 1991, he has annually taught CEQA Update courses on behalf of the Association of Environmental Professionals. He has also frequently participated in CEQA courses put on by the California State Bar and CLE International.
